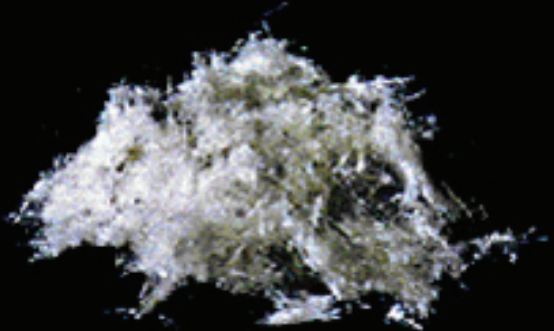

Asbestos awareness - What is asbestos?

There are 3 types of Asbestos:

Chrysotile (white)  
95% of all Asbestos which was discovered in 1850 at Quebec. Chrysotile has a hair-like texture.

Amosite (brown)  
5% of all Asbestos was discovered in 1907 South Africa. Amosite has a needle-like texture.

Crocidolite (blue)  
1% of all Asbestos. Crocidolite was discovered in 1905 in Africa.
